**Psa. 119:89 Forever, O LORD, Thy
word is settled in heaven.**

**Psa. 119:90 Thy faithfulness
continues throughout all
generations; Thou didst establish the
earth, and it stands.**

**Heb. 13:6 so that we confidently say,
“The Lord is my helper, I will not be
afraid. What shall man do to me?”**

**Psa. 37:28 For the LORD loves
justice, And does not forsake His
godly ones; They are preserved
forever; But the descendants of the
wicked will be cut off.**

Psa. 18:2 The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

**Psa. 22:24 For He has not despised
nor abhorred the affliction of the
afflicted; Neither has He hidden His

**They shall mount up with wings like
