John 3:16, “God loved the world in this way that He gave His unique Son that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.”

Rom. 5:8, “God demonstrated His love toward us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died as a substitute for us.”

Heb. 12:5, “And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: ‘My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him;

Heb. 12:6, “ ‘For whom the LORD loves He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives.’ ” [Quote from Prov. 3:11–12]

Lev. 26:4, “then I will give you rain in its season, the land shall yield its produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit.

Lev. 26:5, “Your threshing shall last till the time of vintage, and the vintage shall last till the time of sowing; you shall eat your bread to the full, and dwell in your land safely.”

Lev. 26:27, “And after all this, if you do not obey Me, but walk contrary to Me,

Lev. 26:28, “then I also will walk contrary to you in fury; and I, even I, will chastise you seven times for your sins.

Lev. 26:29, “You shall eat the flesh of your sons, and you shall eat the flesh of your daughters.”

Deut. 28:15, “But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you today, that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you:”

Deut. 28:17, “Cursed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl.”

Deut. 28:20, “The LORD will send on you cursing, confusion, and rebuke in all that you set your hand to do, until you are destroyed and until you perish quickly, because of the wickedness of your doings in which you have forsaken Me.”

Deut. 28:23, “And your heavens which are over your head shall be bronze, and the earth which is under you shall be iron.”

Deut. 28:24, “The LORD will change the rain of your land to powder and dust; from the heaven it shall come down on you until you are destroyed.

Deut. 28:25, “The LORD will cause you to be defeated before your enemies; you shall go out one way against them and flee seven ways before them; and you shall become troublesome to all the kingdoms of the earth.”

Deut. 28:26, “Your carcasses shall be food for all the birds of the air and the beasts of the earth, and no one shall frighten them away.”

Deut. 28:45, “Moreover all these curses shall come upon you and pursue and overtake you, until you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which He commanded you.

Deut. 28:46, “And they shall be upon you for a sign and a wonder, and on your descendants forever.”

Deut. 28:47, “Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joy and gladness of heart, for the abundance of everything,”

Deut. 28:49, “The LORD will bring a nation against you from afar, from the end of the earth, as swift as the eagle flies, a nation whose language you will not understand,”

Deut. 28:52, “They shall besiege you at all your gates until your high and fortified walls, in which you trust, come down throughout all your land; and they shall besiege you at all your gates throughout all your land which the LORD your God has given you.

Deut. 28:53, “You shall eat the fruit of your own body, the flesh of your sons and your daughters whom the LORD your God has given you, in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you.”

Deut. 28:54, “The sensitive and very refined man among you will be hostile toward his brother, toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the rest of his children whom he leaves behind,

Deut. 28:55, “so that he will not give any of them the flesh of his children whom he will eat, because he has nothing left in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you at all your gates.”

Deut. 28:56, “The tender and delicate woman among you, who would not venture to set the sole of her foot on the ground because of her delicateness and sensitivity, will refuse to the husband of her bosom, and to her son and her daughter,

Deut. 28:57, “her placenta which comes out from between her feet and her children whom she bears; for she will eat them secretly for lack of everything in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you at all your gates.”

Deut. 28:58, “If you do not carefully observe all the words of this law that are written in this book, that you may fear this glorious and awesome name, THE LORD YOUR GOD,”
