acc fem sing

servant, minister, deacon

προστάτις *prostatis*

nom fem sing

ruler, leader; (m)

patron, benefactor (f)

Rom. 16:4, “who risked their own necks for my life, to whom not only I give thanks, but also all the churches of the Gentiles.
