# THESSALONIANS

THEREFORE, COMFORT ONE  
ANOTHER WITH THESE WORDS

**STEP ONE: Claim a promise**

**STEP TWO: Think through the doctrinal rationales embedded in the promise**

**STEP THREE: Appropriate the doctrinal conclusions**

**1. The more things you surrender to fear, the more things you fear.**

**2. The extent to which you surrender to fear,  
the greater is your capacity for fear.**

**3. The greater your capacity for fear, the more you increase the power of fear in your life.**

**4. The more you increase the power of fear in your life, the greater your failure to live the spiritual life and grow to spiritual maturity.**

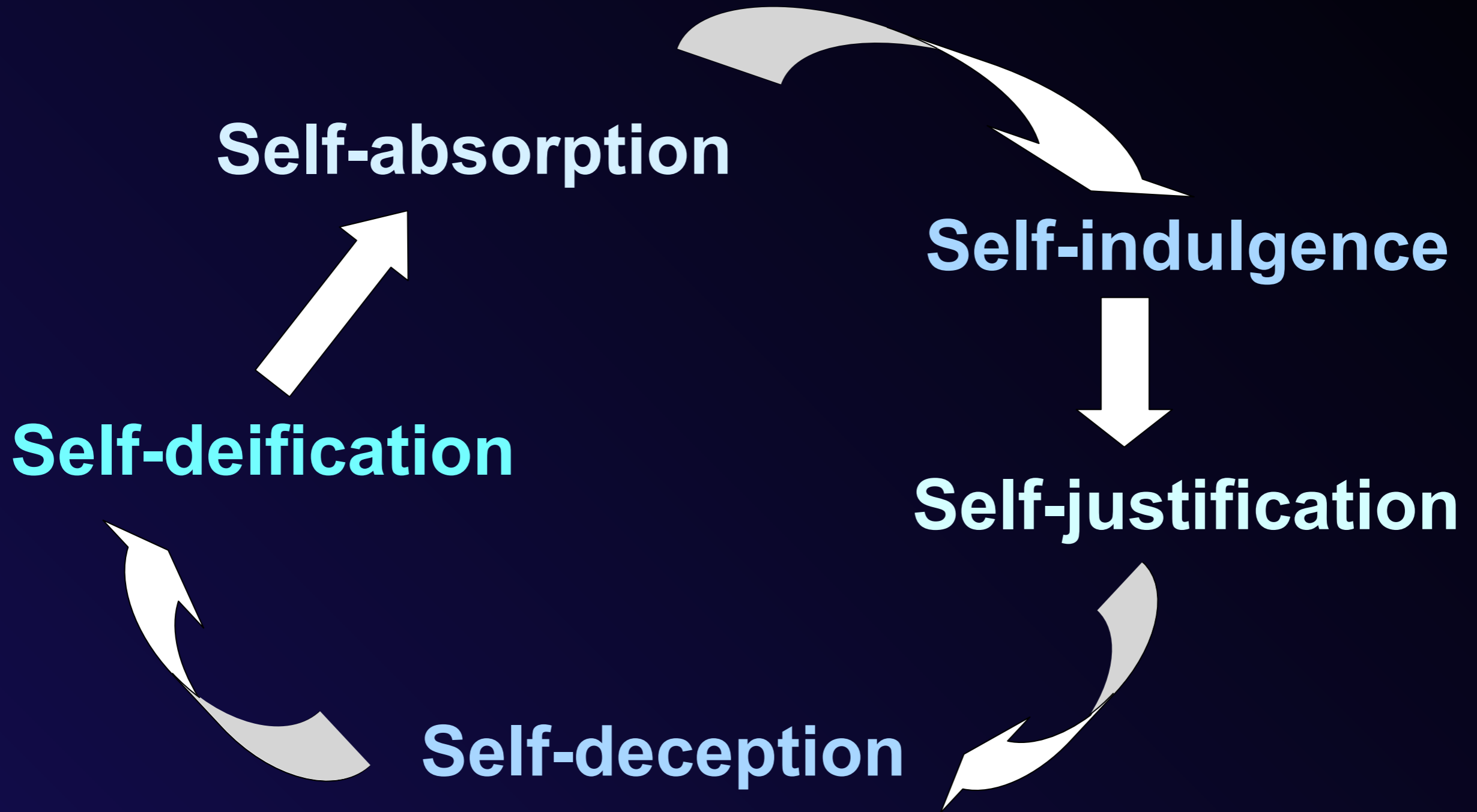
