What about statements that a person dies in their sin?

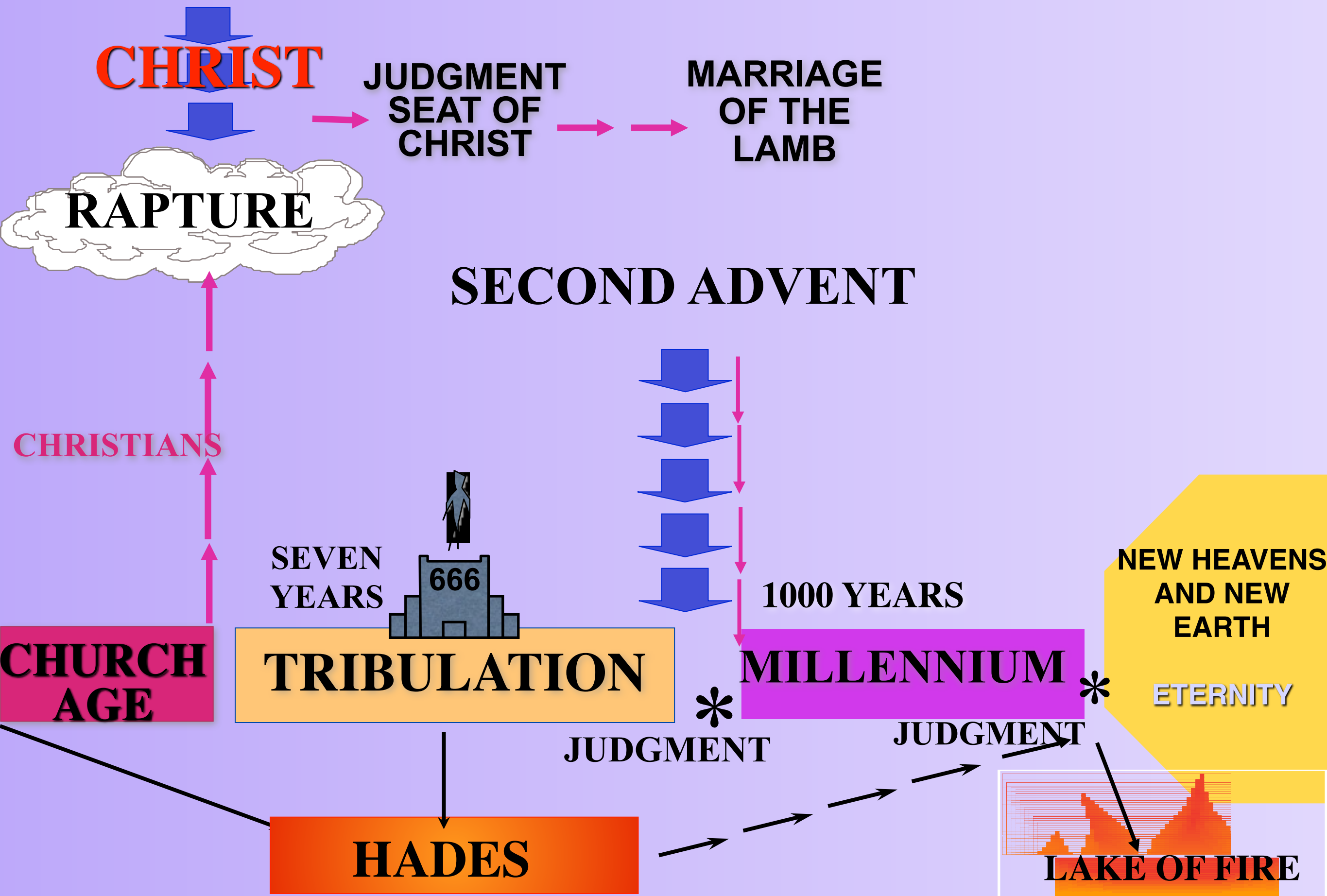
“in your sins” John 8:24.
