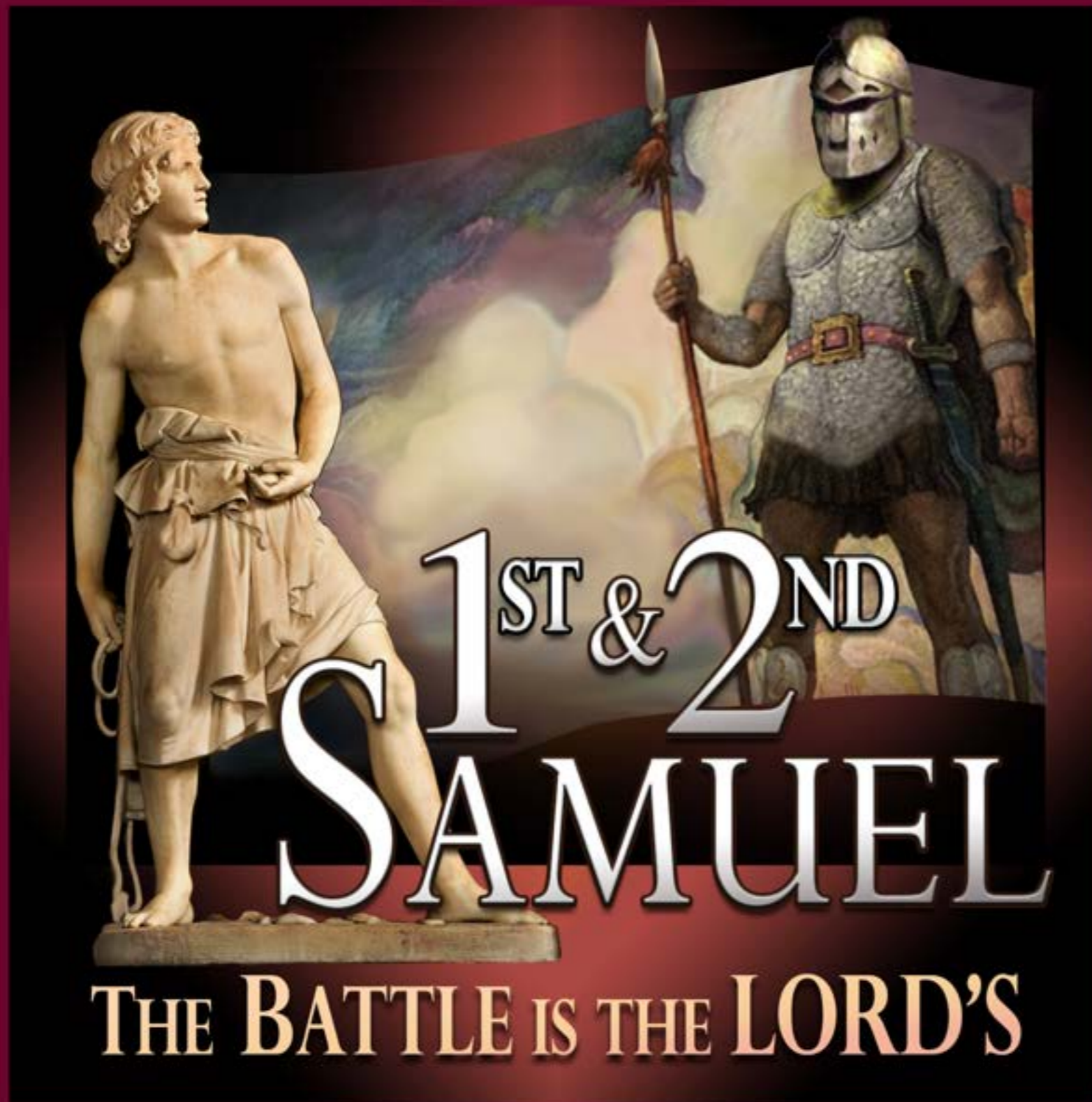

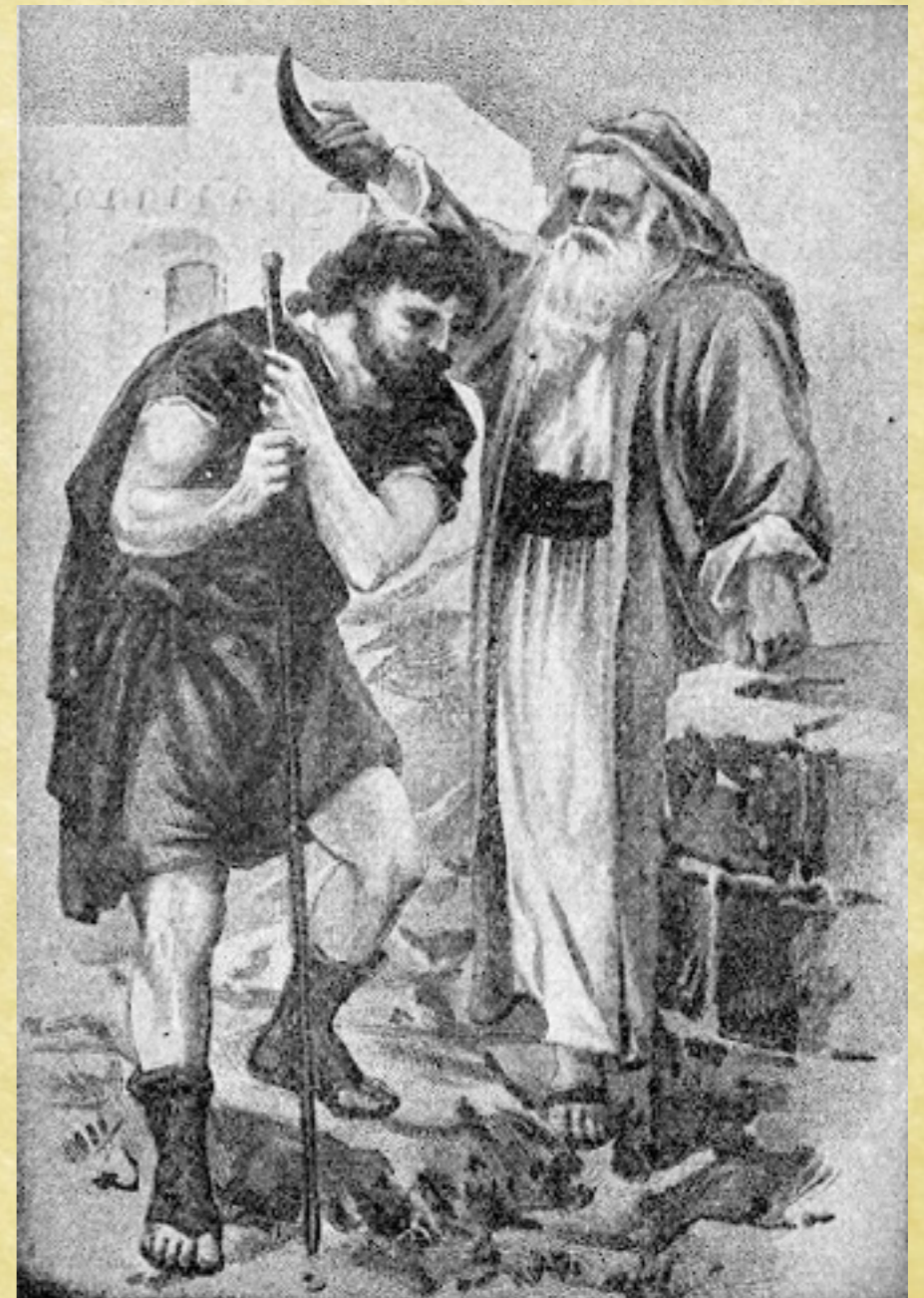
I. The Lord selects and anoints Saul to be King over Israel. 1 Samuel 9:1–10:16

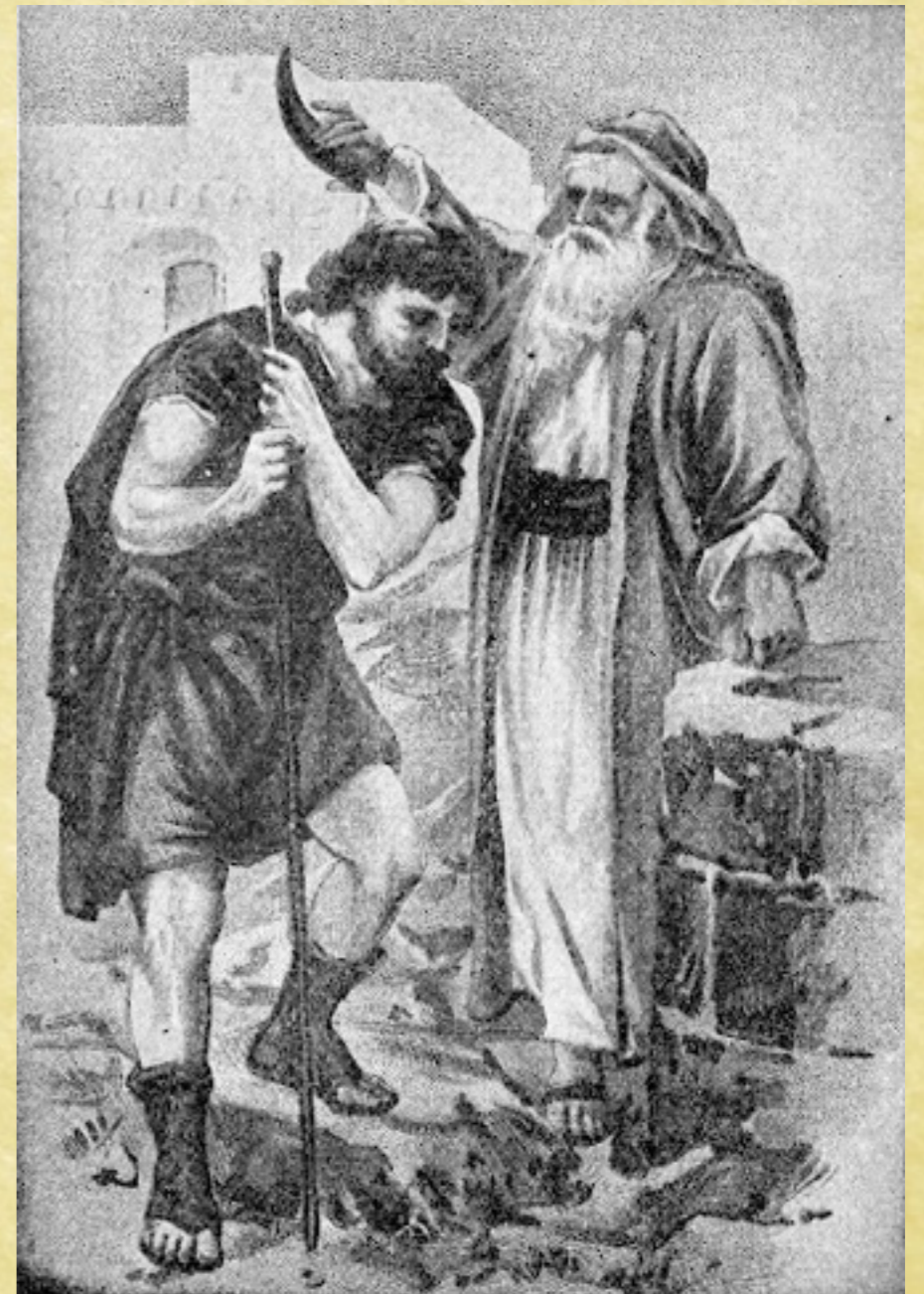
