## **Two Categories of Revelation**

קזוֹן chazon vision

אָלְה  $(g\bar{a}la)$  uncover, remove, in the sense of removing blinders from the eyes.

Num. 24:4, "The utterance of him who hears the words of God, Who sees (chazah) the vision (machzah) of the Almighty, Who falls down, with eyes wide open (galah):"

ἀποκαλύπτω (apokalyptō), uncover, disclose, reveal; ἀποκάλυψις (apokalypsis), disclosure, revelation

## Revelation

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Special Revelation: the direct, verbal self-disclosure of God to His creatures, i.e., a theophany, the Urim and Thummim, the Scriptures, non-recorded verbal communication to mankind.

Jer. 17:9, "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; Who can know it?"

Eccl. 9:3, "This is an evil in all that is done under the sun: that one thing happens to all. Truly the hearts of the sons of men are full of evil; madness is in their hearts while they live, and after that they go to the dead."

Psa. 19:4, "... In them He has set a tabernacle for the sun,

Psa. 19:5, "Which is like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoices like a strong man to run its race.

Psa. 19:6, "Its rising is from one end of heaven, and its circuit to the other end; And there is nothing hidden from its heat."



Psa. 19:7, "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;

## 2. The testimony of the Lord; Psa. 19:7b

phrase 1× here, but the Ark is often called the Ark of the Testimony, because it contains the tablets of the Law. Testimony is a synonym for covenant.

Psa. 19:10, "More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb."

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קמה hāmad "Desire, delight in." Cf., Ugaritic hmd "be pleasant," but also covet, lust after (ASV and RSV similar but in the positive contexts [eleven of twentyone] prefer the less ambiguous "delight in"). The Arabic hamida means praise and the name Mohammed comes from the root. TWOT

Psa. 19:11, "Moreover by them Your servant is warned, and in keeping them there is great reward."

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- 2 Tim. 3:16, "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,
- 2 Tim. 3:17, "that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."
