Philippians

brethren, that the things which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the Gospel;

13 So that my bonds in all the palace, and in all other places, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak Christ without fear.



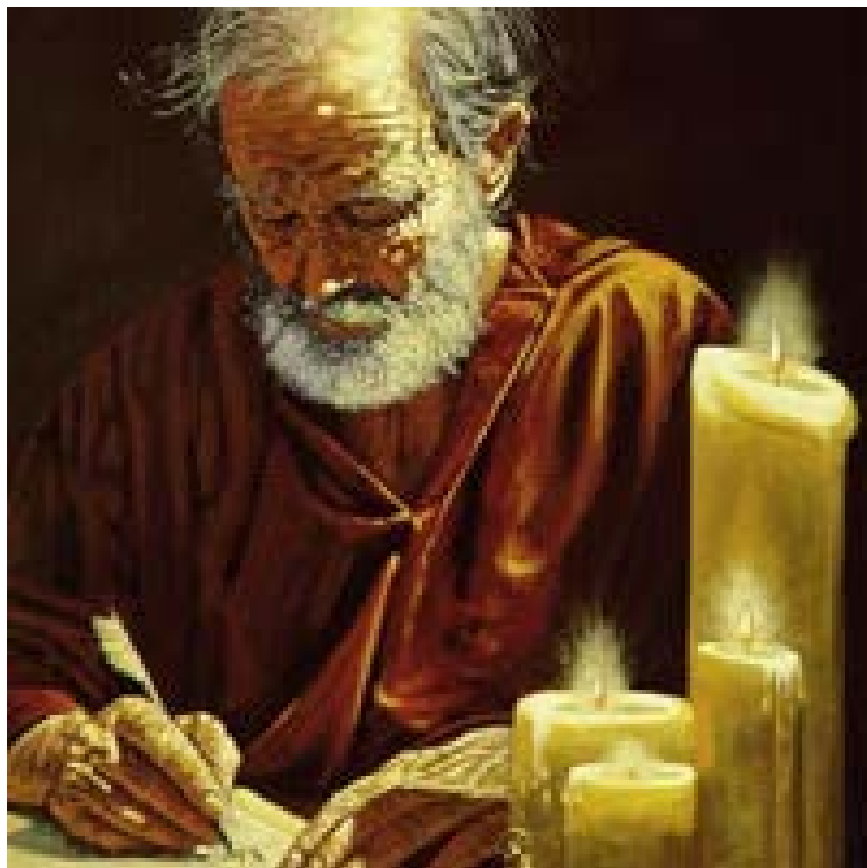
