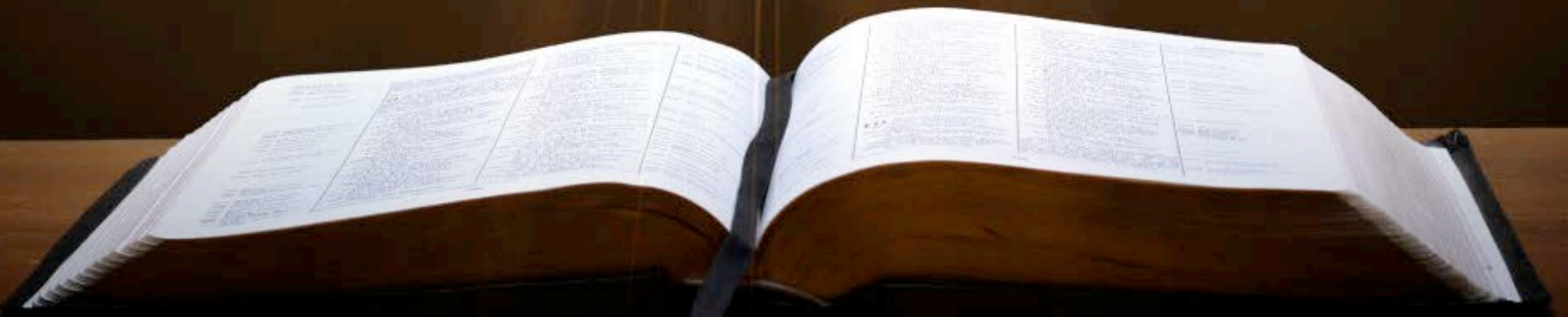

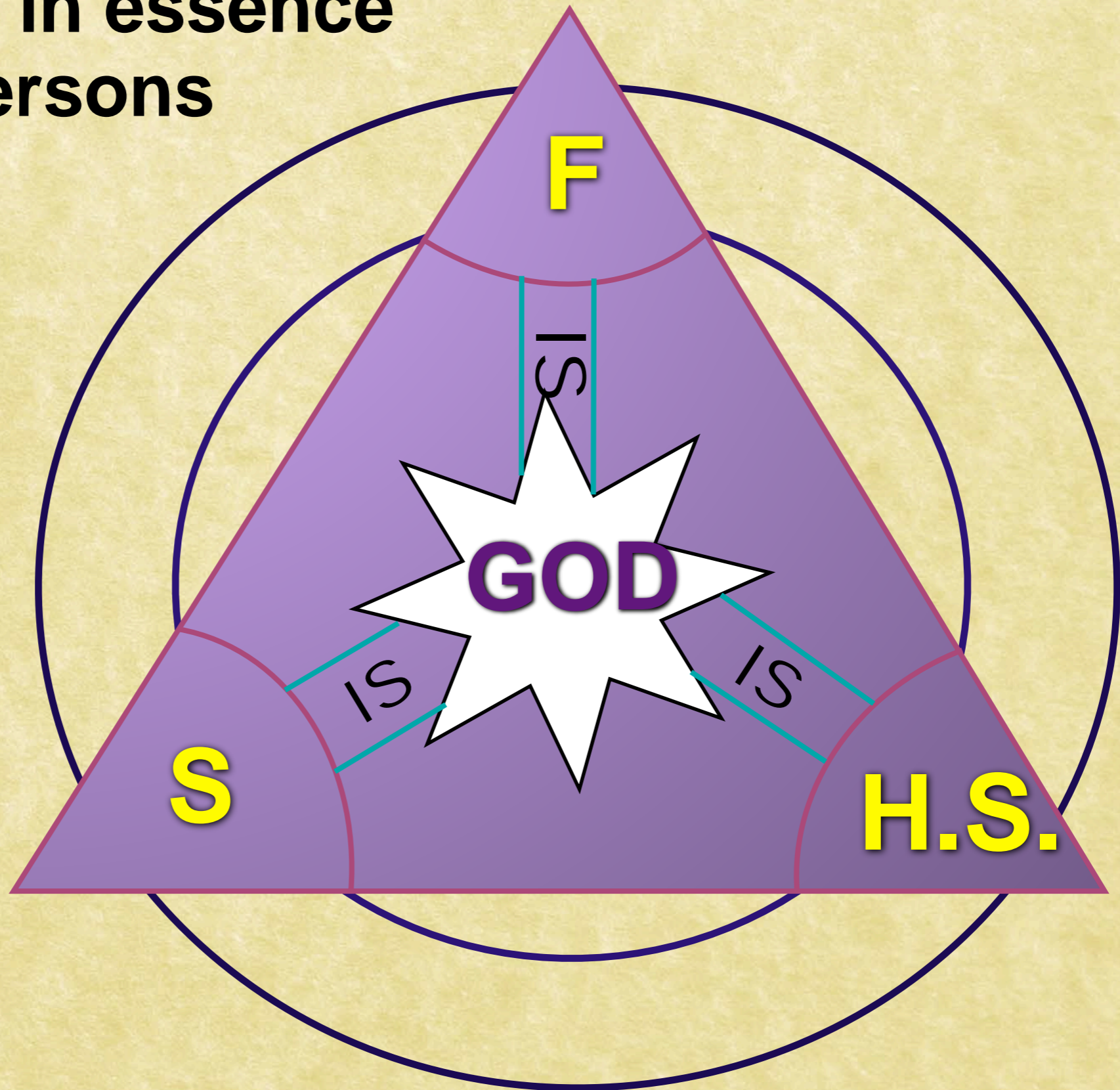

Father is the planner, the architect.

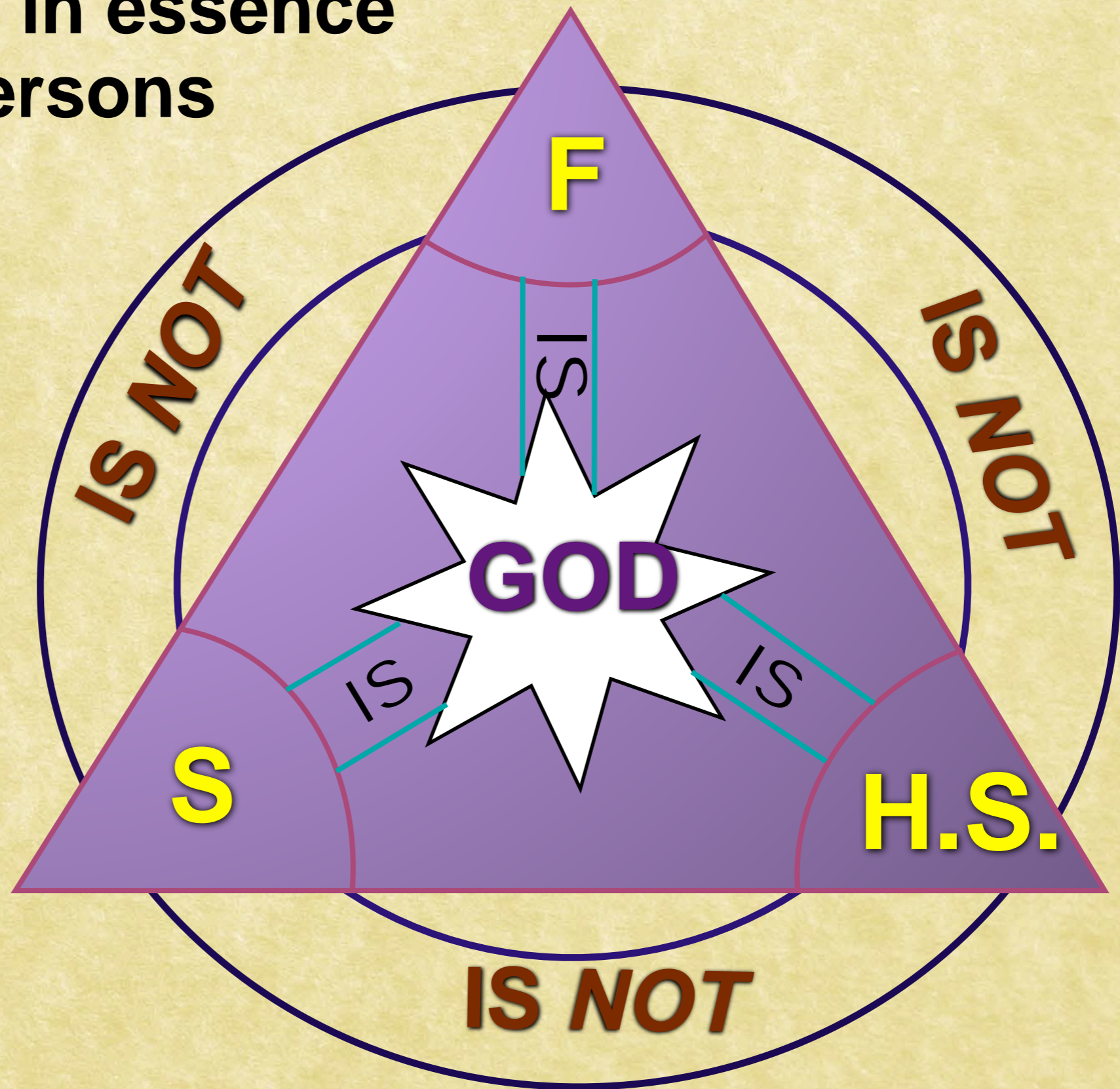
Son is the one who carries out the plan of salvation.

ἁγιασμός *hagiasmos* Noun masc sing dative literally: “setting apart” sanctification, consecration. The setting apart of the believer to the service of God through spiritual growth.

The Constant Struggle

Gal. 5:17, “For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.”

Active voice imperative is directed to our volition, *we are to choose to obey the command.*

But a passive voice command means we let something happen to us, or receive something.

Eph. 5:18, “And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but **be filled with the Spirit,**”

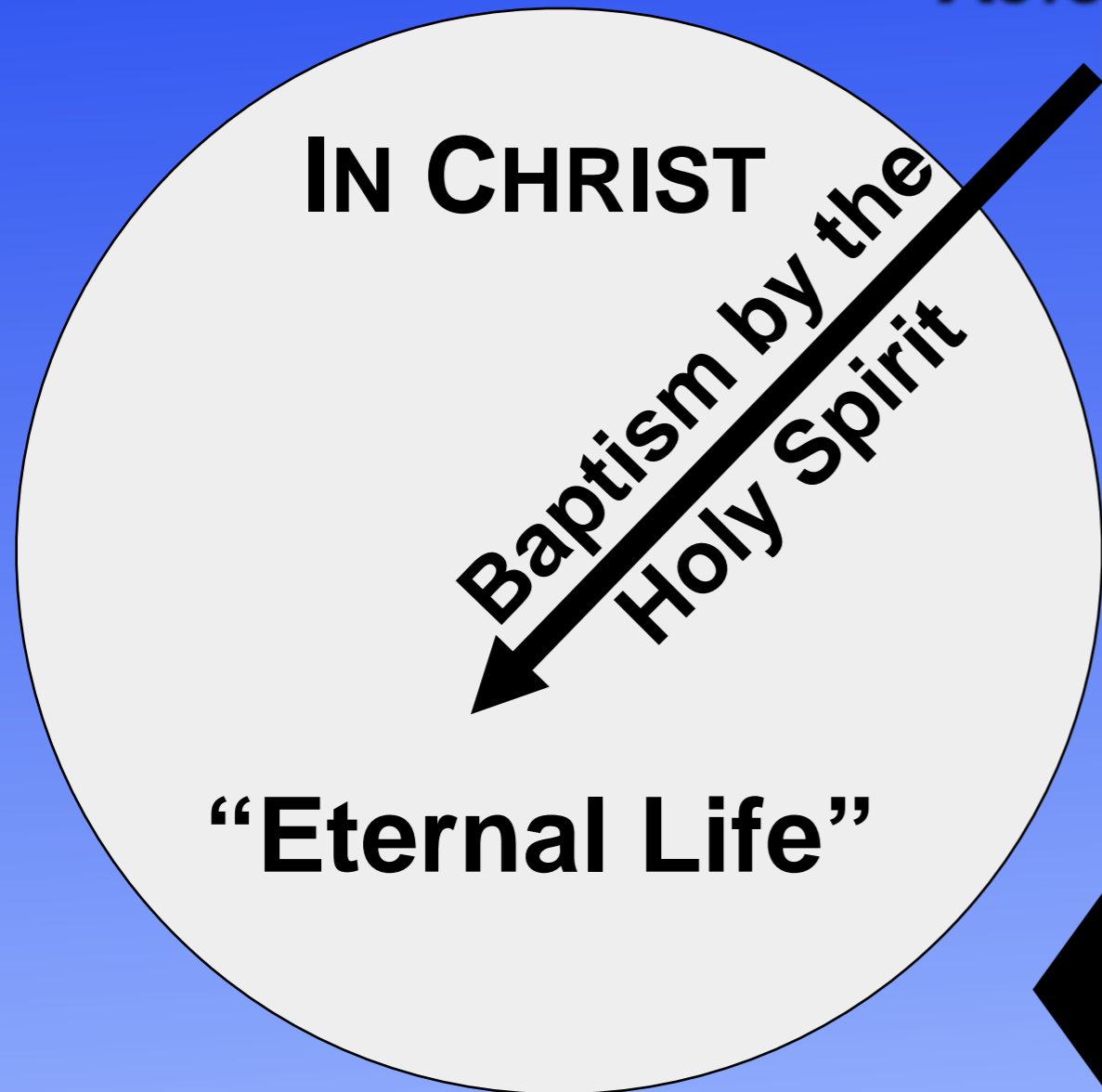
