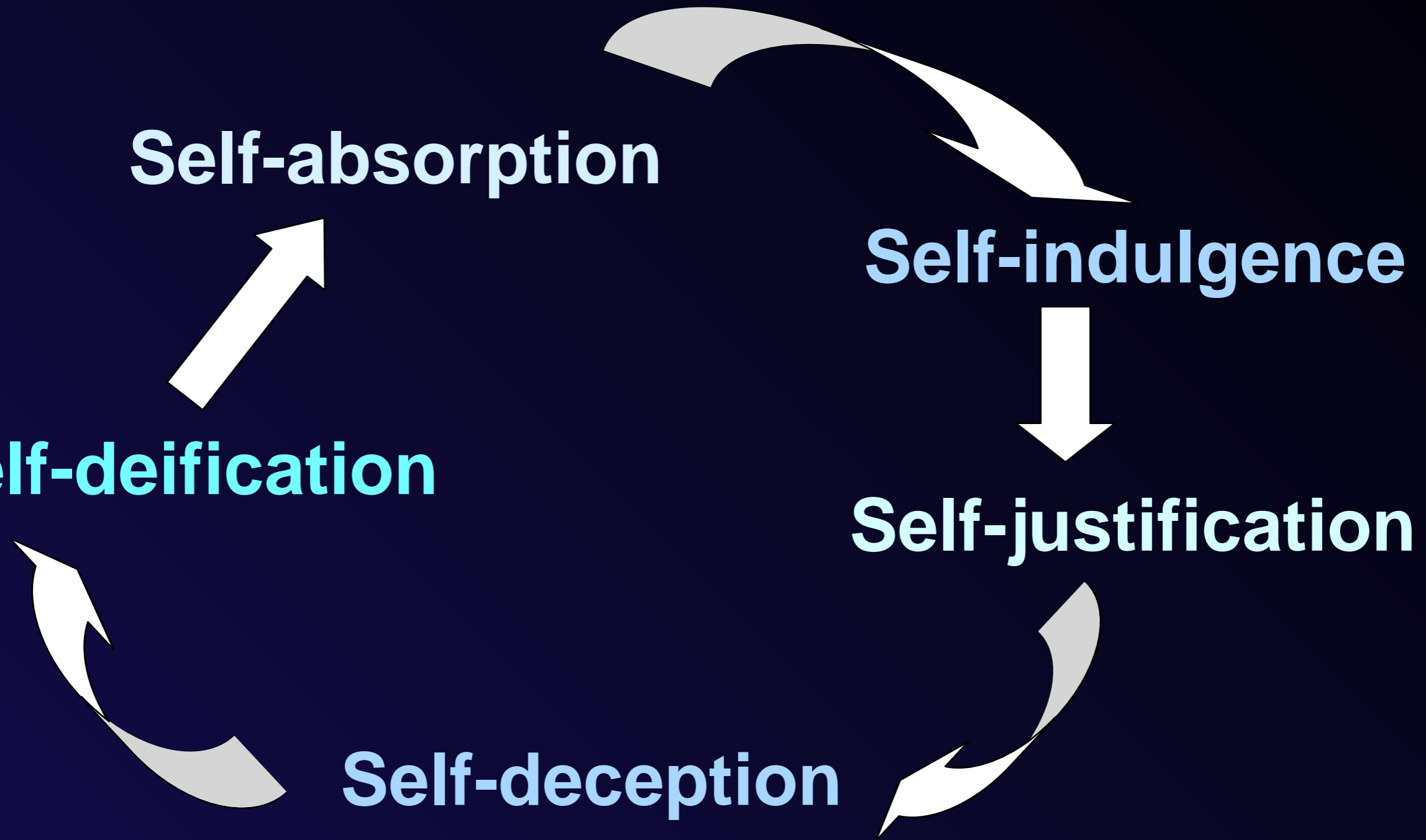

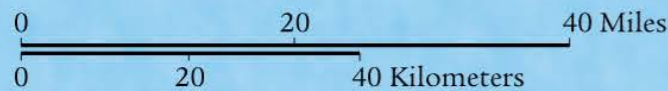

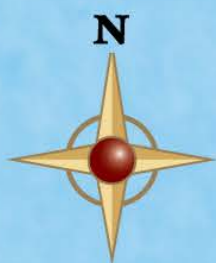


# HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT OF MODERN ISRAEL

- City
- Modern political boundaries
- - - Territories with disputed boundaries
- International zone (November 29, 1947) – UN partition accords
- Territory allotted to Israel (November 29, 1947) – UN partition accords
- Territory conquered by Israel in the 1948 war
- Territory occupied by Israel in the June, 1967 war (6-day war)
- Territory occupied by Israel in the June, 1967 war (returned to Egypt in April, 1982)
- Territory occupied by Israel in March, 1978 (returned to Lebanon in 1983)
- Projected crossing-points (November 29, 1947) – UN partition accords

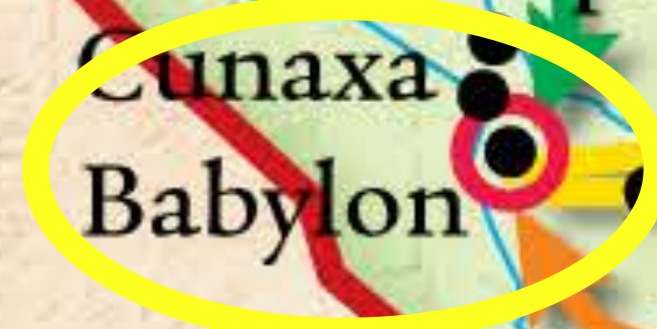

  - a. The seal of perfection,**

  - c. Adorned with jewels similar to Israel's high priest**

**Ezek. 28:18, “You defiled your sanctuaries by the multitude of your iniquities, by the iniquity of your trading; Therefore I brought fire from your midst; It devoured you, and I turned you to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all who saw you.**
