




Soul Fortress Principles

- 1. Construction of the soul fortress takes a lifetime.
- 2. Construction is piecemeal and dynamic.
- 3. Utilization of the spiritual skills enables us to stay inside the fortress, failure to use these leaves us outside, vulnerable to damage from sin, the world, and the devil.
- 4. When we fail to utilize the spiritual skills, we default to the arrogance skills.
