

Num. 32:13, "So the LORD'S anger was aroused against Israel, and He made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation that had done evil in the sight of the Lord was gone."

## The Consequences of Historical "Forgetting" or cancelling the past!

1. History is the outworking of the plan and purposes of God for human history. Therefore history is objective and the events of history are rationally and cogently discernible.

2. Since history is the objective arena within which God operates, to destroy objectivity destroys meaning in history and to destroy history destroys the objectivity of God. The greatest victim when meaning in history is destroyed is truth.

"On the tomb of the nineteenth century Church historian Bishop Mandel Creighton are inscribed the words 'He tried to write true history.' Like the bishop—who was a member of my own college at Oxford—I believe that there is such a thing as 'true history'."

3. Thus with God and objectivity removed, the vacuum is filled with subjective impressions and feelings created and imposed by man upon creation.

4. By destroying history and objectivity of meaning in history you destroy man and any meaning in man and the events of mankind, i.e., history.

5. In post-modernism the big evil is western civilization, so Europe is denigrated and all other cultures are elevated, whether there is real, objective evidence to support it or not.

In the Critical Social Justice worldview, the enemy is every white person, they are by definition racists. The purpose is to divide and create hostility between the races in the same way the Bolsheviks and Chinese communists created class hostility to generate their revolutions to destroy those nations.

6. Historians locate the ultimate cause inside history, not outside. It is in economics, trends, classes, environment.

7. So we have exchanged the historically active objective God of the Bible for the emotionally energizing, exciting god of post-modernism, an idol of our own feelings, emotions, and whims.

"'Men do not make history,' he wrote in the final passage of *The Identity of France*, 'rather it is history above all that makes men and absolves them of blame.'"

Rom. 1:18, "For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

Rom. 1:19, "because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them.
