### Philippians 2 – Thinking the same thing

**Philippians:** <sup>2.1</sup>Therefore, if *there is* any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of spirit, if there is any affection and compassion, <sup>2.2</sup>fill up my joy, in that you might think the same thing, having the same love, souled-together, thinking the one thing, <sup>2.3</sup>\_\_\_\_\_ing nothing according to selfishness or according to conceit, but in humility of mind regarding one another *as* being held above yourselves, <sup>2.4</sup>each one not attentively watching the things of themselves, but everyone [*also*] *attentively watching* the things of others. <sup>2.5</sup>Think this thing among you which *is* also in Christ Jesus, . . .

<sup>4.2</sup>I urge Euodia and I urge Suntuche to live in harmony in *the* Lord. <sup>4.3</sup>Yes, genuine comrade, I ask you indeed to work with these women who have struggled with me in the cause of the gospel . . . [middle of AD 61]

**Philippians:** <sup>2.1</sup>Therefore, if *there is* any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of spirit, if there is any affection and compassion, <sup>2,2</sup> fill up my joy, in that you might think the same thing, having the same love, souled-together, thinking the one thing, <sup>2.3</sup> ing nothing according to selfishness or according to conceit, but in humility of mind regarding one another as being held above yourselves, <sup>2,4</sup>each one not attentively watching the things of themselves, but everyone [also] attentively watching the things of others. <sup>2.5</sup>Think this thing among you which is also in Christ Jesus, <sup>2.6</sup>who—while existing in *the* form of God—did not regard equality with God a thing to be held onto tightly, <sup>2.7</sup>but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, becoming one who exists in the form of human beings, and found in outward appearance as a man. <sup>2.8</sup>He humbled himself, becoming obedient until death, even death on a cross. <sup>2.9</sup>For this reason, God highly exalted him and graced him with the name that is above every (**Ephesians:** 5.25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the Church, and *fully* gave of himself for her.)

Theme: Unity comes only through humility
