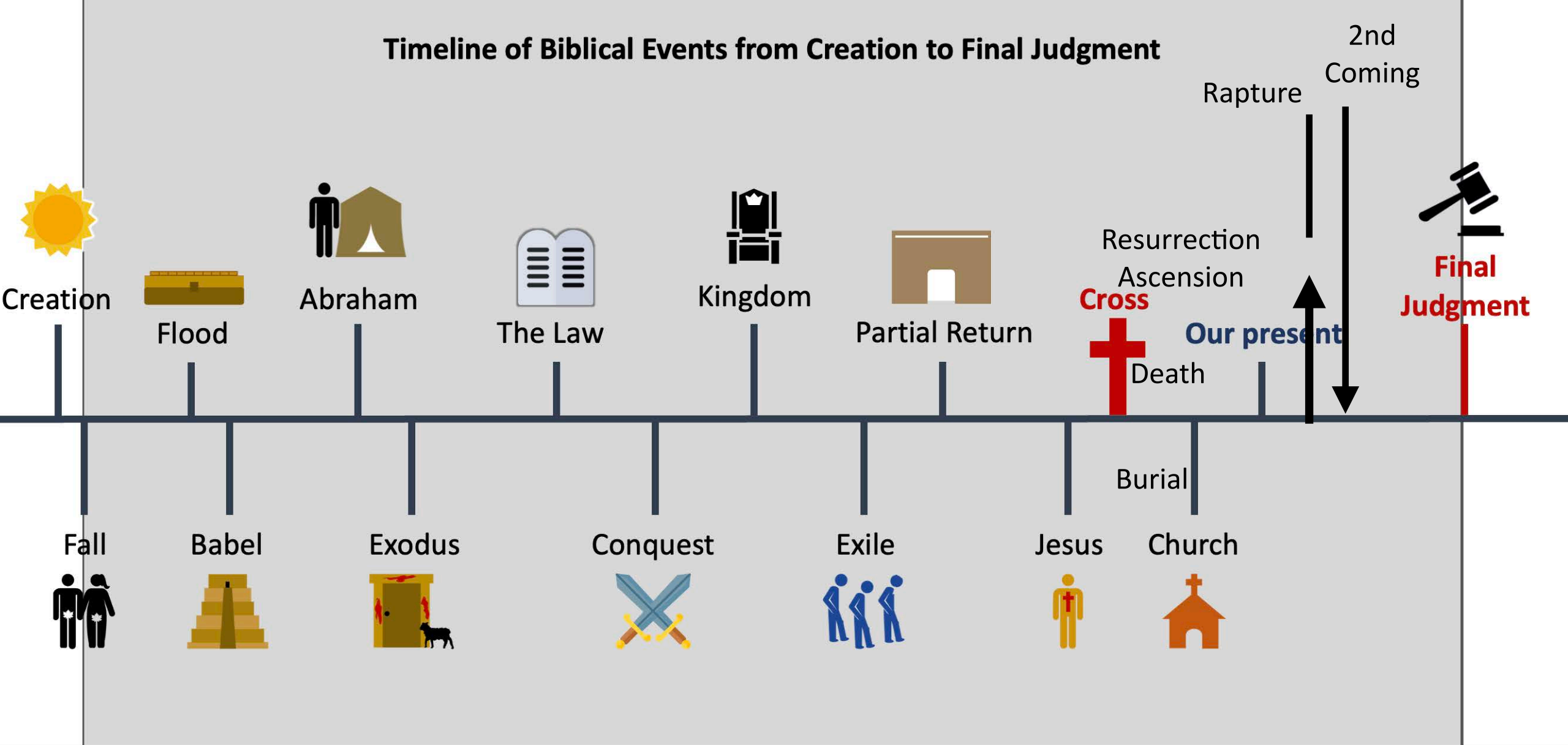

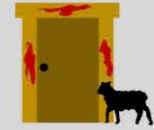

God created everything out of nothing! Before God created there was nothing, not even empty space! not even invisible air!

Gen. 1:1, “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Gen. 1:2, “The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.” [NLT]

Gen. 1:3, “Then God said, ‘Let there be light,’ and there was light.

Gen. 1:4, “And God saw that the light was good. Then he separated the light from the darkness.

Gen. 1:5, “God called the light ‘day’ and the darkness ‘night.’ And evening passed and morning came, marking the first day.” [NLT]

Psa. 33:6, “By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.”

First 3 Days: Domains	Second 3 days: Occupants
  Domain of light and darkness	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sun for day• Moon and stars for night  
  Domain of sea and atmosphere	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fish for sea• Birds for atmosphere  
 Domain of land	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Animals for land• Man to rule fish, birds, animals  

**Ex. 20:11, “For in six days the LORD made the heavens,

seventh day he rested. That is why the LORD blessed the
Sabbath day and set it apart as holy.”**

What Have We Learned

- 1. So far we have learned that God is the Creator of everything. Nothing was made apart from God creating it.**
- 2. We learned that God is different from His creation. He did not make it out of His own body, or out of something else.**
- 3. We learned that God must be all-powerful.**

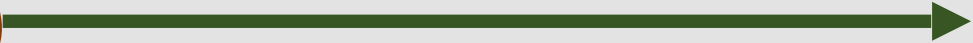

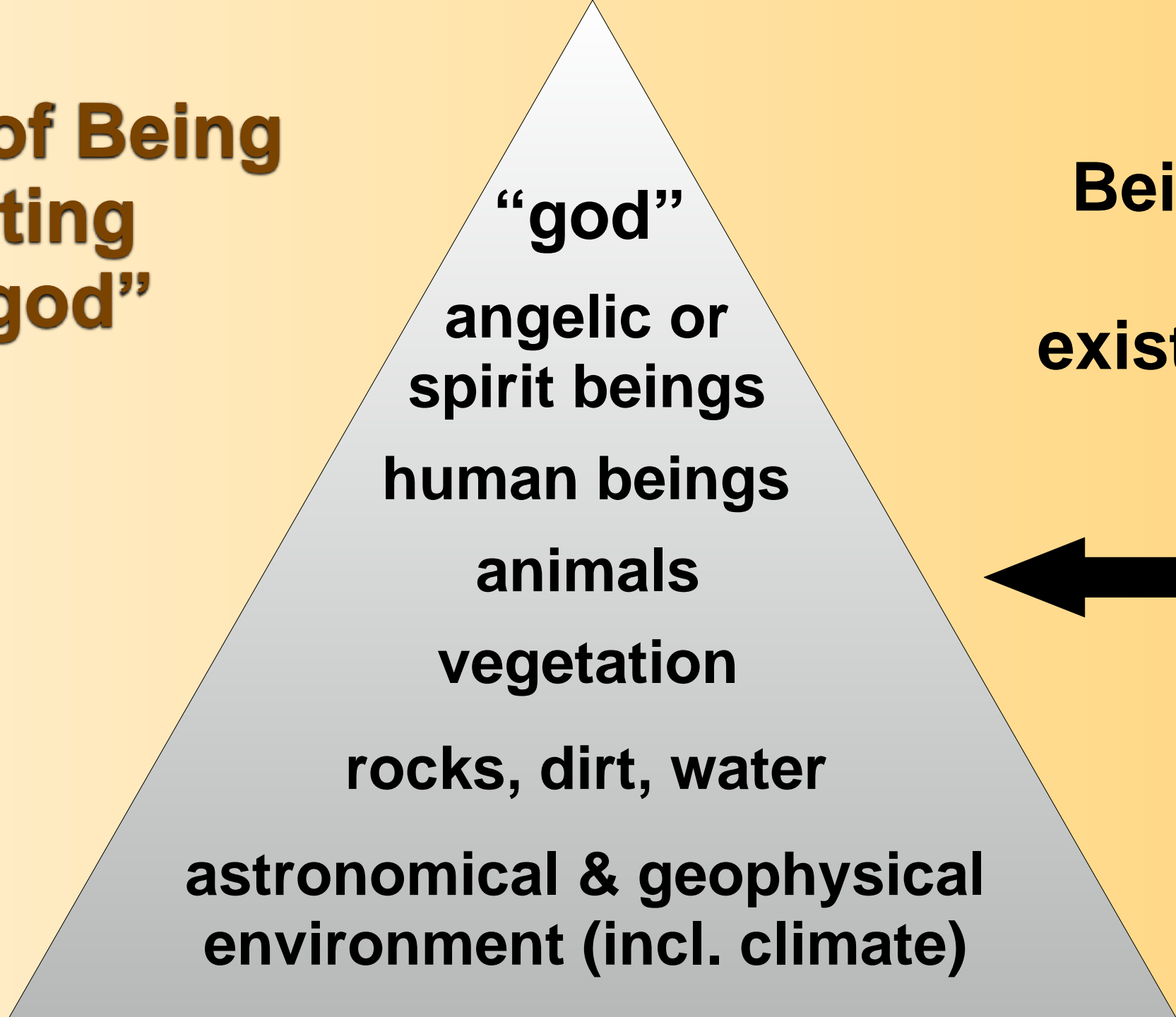

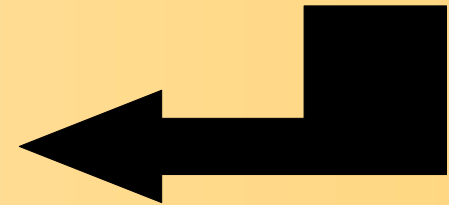

Psa. 50:12, “If I were hungry, I would not tell you, for all the world is mine and everything in it.

Psa. 50:13, “Do I eat the meat of bulls? Do I drink the blood of goats?”

Acts 17:24, “He is the God who made the world and everything in it. Since he is Lord of heaven and earth, he doesn’t live in man-made temples,

Acts 17:25, “and human hands can’t serve his needs—for he has no needs. He himself gives life and breath to everything, and he satisfies every need.”

Isa. 44:24, “This is what the LORD says—your Redeemer and Creator: ‘I am the LORD, who made all things. I alone stretched out the heavens. Who was with me when I made the earth?’ ”

Isa. 46:9, “Remember the things I have done in the past. For I alone am God! I am God, and there is none like me.”

“One of a kind” means unique, or distinct. Another word for this is HOLY.

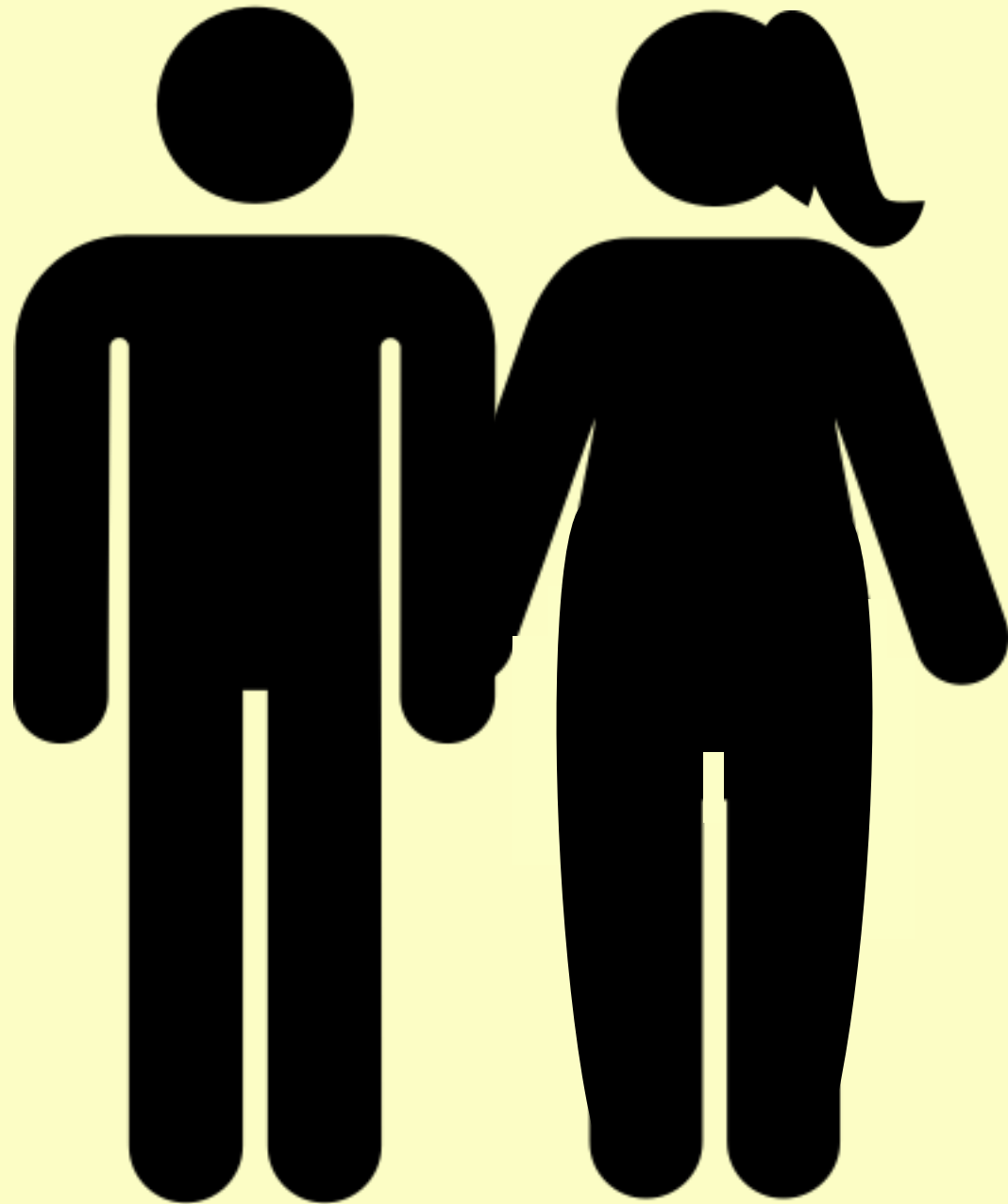
