Let's pray that God will use those books to bring salvation for our soldiers. Unfortunately really bad situation on front line. Lot of soldiers died or injured.

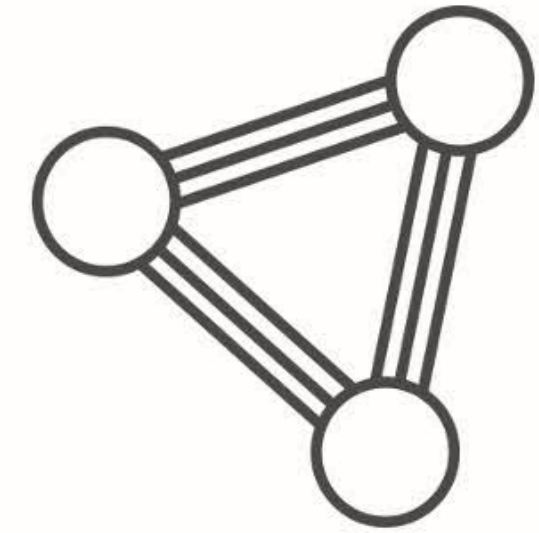

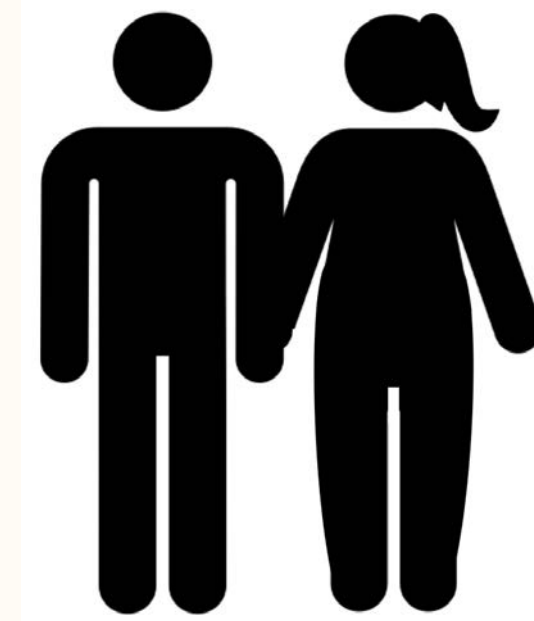
Blood Atonement

***Sheol* is the Old Testament Hebrew name for the place of the dead. This name is often translated into English as “the grave”, “realm/place of the dead”, or “the depths”.**

Examples: Genesis 37:35; 44:29; Psalm 9:17; 16:10; 88:3; 89:48; 139:8; Proverbs 9:18; Isaiah 5:15; 14:9; Habakkuk 2:5.

***Hades* is the New Testament Greek word for “the place of the dead”. Both Sheol and Hades refer to the same place.**

Examples: Matthew 11:23; 16:18; Luke 10:15; Acts 2:27, 31; Revelation 1:18; 6:8. (Note: Acts 2:27 quotes Psalm 16:10 but replaces Sheol with Hades.)

Luke 16:19, “There was a certain rich man who was clothed in purple and fine linen and fared sumptuously every day.

Luke 16:20 “But there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, full of sores, who was laid at his gate,

Luke 16:21, “desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man’s table. Moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

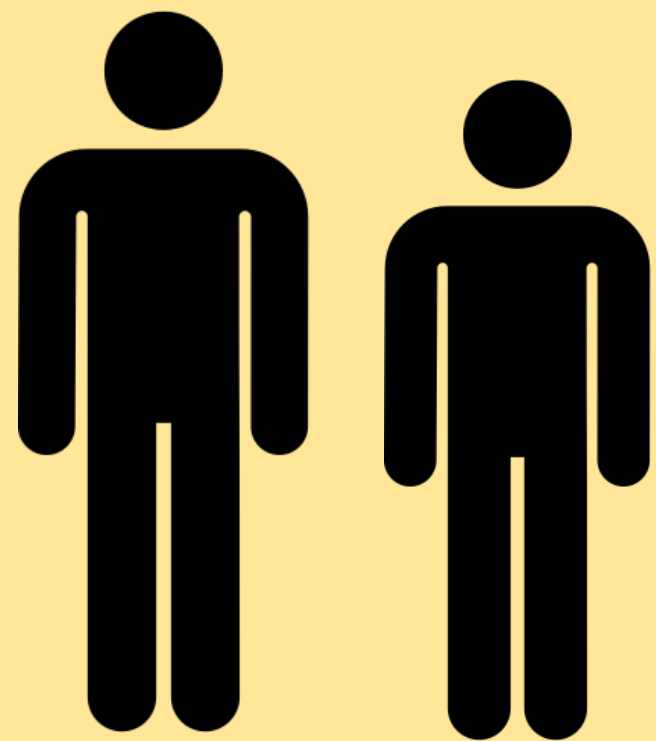
Luke 16:22, “So it was that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels to Abraham’s bosom. The rich man also died and was buried.

Luke 16:23, “And being in torments in Hades, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.”

Luke 16:24, “Then he cried and said, ‘Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.’”

Luke 16:25, “But Abraham said, ‘Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted and you are tormented.”

Luke 16:26, “ ‘And besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed, so that those who want to pass from here to you cannot, nor can those from there pass to us.’ ”

Luke 16:27, “Then he said, ‘I beg you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father’s house,

Luke 16:28, “ ‘for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, lest they also come to this place of torment.’

Luke 16:29, “Abraham said to him, ‘They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.’

Luke 16:30, “And he said, ‘No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will change their mind.’

Luke 16:31, “But he said to him, ‘If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead.’ ”

Isa. 14:3, “It shall come to pass in the day the LORD gives you rest from your sorrow, and from your fear and the hard bondage in which you were made to serve,

Isa. 14:4, “that you will take up this proverb against the king of Babylon, and say: ‘How the oppressor has ceased, the golden city ceased!

Isa. 14:5, “ ‘The LORD has broken the staff of the wicked, the scepter of the rulers;

Isa. 14:6, “ ‘He who struck the people in wrath with a continual stroke, He who ruled the nations in anger, is persecuted and no one hinders.

Isa. 14:7, “ ‘The whole earth is at rest and quiet; They break forth into singing.’ ”

Isa. 14:8, “ ‘Indeed the cypress trees rejoice over you, and the cedars of Lebanon, saying, “Since you were cut down, no woodsman has come up against us.”

Isa. 14:9, “ ‘Hell [Sheol] from beneath is excited about you, to meet you at your coming; It stirs up the dead for you, all the chief ones of the earth; It has raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations.

Isa. 14:10, “ ‘They all shall speak and say to you: “Have you also become as weak as we? Have you become like us?

Isa. 14:11, “ ‘ “Your pomp is brought down to Sheol, and the sound of your stringed instruments; The maggot is spread under you, and worms cover you.” ’ ”

Rev. 9:1, “Then the fifth angel sounded: And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit [abyss].”

Rev. 9:2, “And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit.”

Rev. 9:11, “And they had as king over them the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in Hebrew is Abaddon, but in Greek he has the name Apollyon.”

Rev. 11:7, “When they finish their testimony, the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit will make war against them, overcome them, and kill them.”

Luke 8:31, “And they kept begging Him that He would not command them to go out into the abyss.”

2 Pet. 2:4, “For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to *tartarus* and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment;”

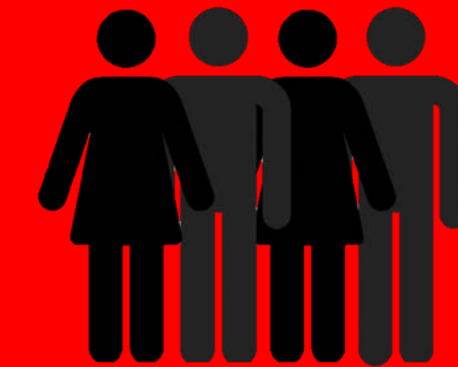

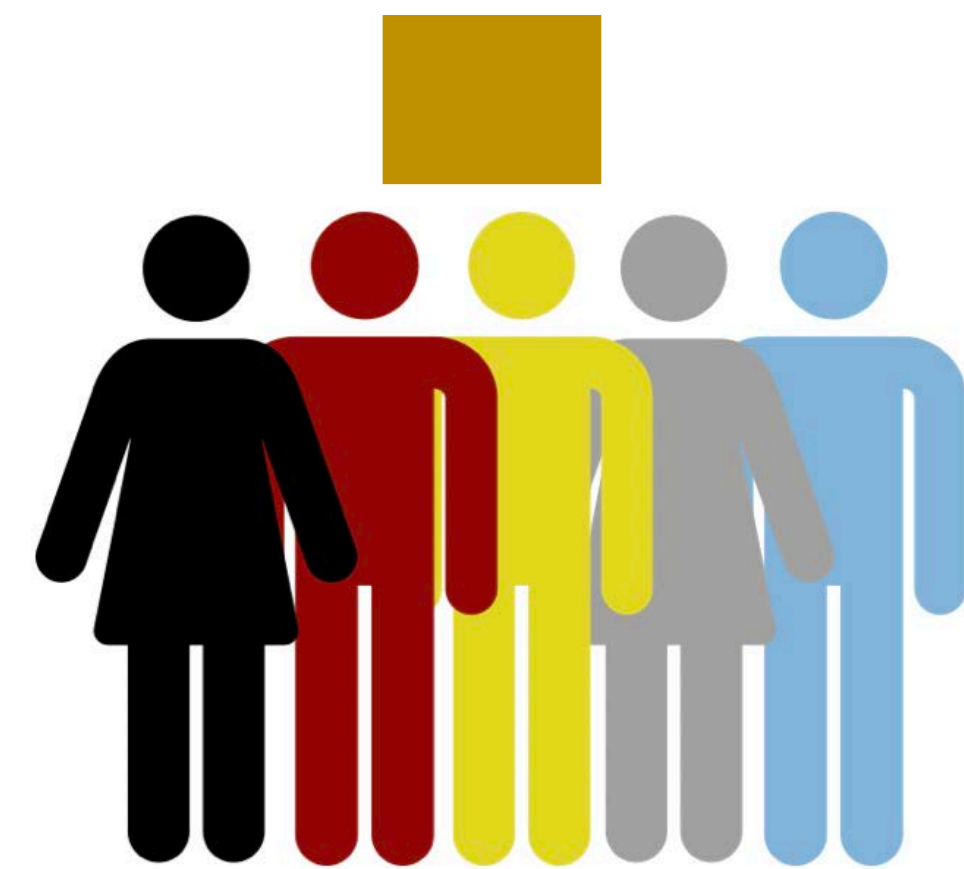
1 Pet. 3:19, “by whom also He went and announced judgment to the spirits in prison,” [RD]

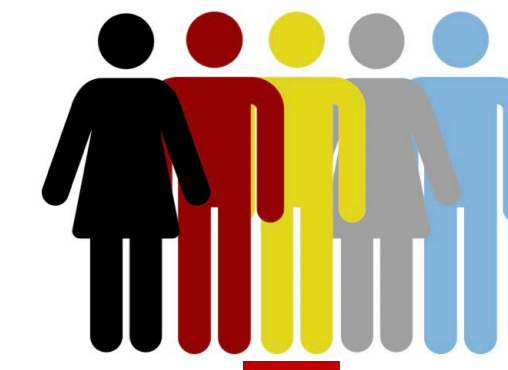
