





Remind people that all of God's Abrahamic Covenant promises will come true in the future Kingdom of God.





<u>Deut. 32:26</u>, "I would have said, 'I will dash them in pieces, I will make the memory of them to cease from among men,' <u>Deut. 32:27</u>, "Had I not feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should misunderstand, lest they should say, 'Our hand is high; And it is not the LORD who has done all this.'"

<u>Deut. 32:36</u>, "For the LORD will judge His people and have compassion on His servants, when He sees that their power is gone, and there is no one remaining, bond or free."

LAND

Isa. 14:1, "For the LORD will have mercy on Jacob, and will still choose Israel, and settle them in their own land. The strangers will be joined with them, and they will cling to the house of Jacob."






Jer. 31:32, "not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD.

Jer. 31:33, "But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

Jer. 31:34, "No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

Jer. 31:38, "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, that the city shall be built for the LORD from the Tower of Hananel to the Corner Gate."

Promises




Remind people that all of God's Abrahamic Covenant promises will come true in the future Kingdom of God.

Continued to sin






- Yahweh forgives their sins.

- How would the holy, righteous *Yahweh* reconcile the rebellious, sinful Israel to an everlasting fellowship with Himself?

What Jesus did to bring mankind from "unrighteous" to "righteous."



The Prophets Are a Model for Us


Creator-Creature Distinction

2nd level creature



God credits righteousness to believers because of what Jesus did




Is the role of a prophet active in the church today?

Eph. 2:20, "having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone,


Eph. 2:21, "in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord,"




Eph. 4:11, "And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers,

Acts 17:10, "Then the brethren immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea. When they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews.



Acts 17:12, "Therefore many of them believed, and also not a few of the Greeks, prominent women as well as men."



Does God reveal and remind believers of truth in the Bible? Yes.


Does God cause believers to share His word of exhortation, encouragement, and rebuke with others? Yes.

Does God work in hearts to convict believers of sin and encourage repentance? Yes.

Does God sometimes supernaturally disrupt our lives and intervene with miracles? Yes.

He can and does at His will.

But none of these is the biblical gift of prophecy!!

1 John 4:1, "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world."





Kings and Prophets
